Downers Grove game retailer Fair Game and the charity organization "Be The Cure" have teamed up this Saturday to help increase awareness and funding for pediatric cancer.

When Casey Patton was diagnosed with a brain tumor 5 years ago, she knew little of pediatric cancer nor the huge costs associated with cancer treatment. Now that has all changed. At the time a high-school student at Downers Grove South, Casey began treatment at Children's Memorial in Chicago. It was during her first phases of treatment that she became acutely aware of the dire state of pediatric cancer research in the United States. Casey decided to act – and in 2007, "Be The Cure" was started. To date, they have raised over \$76,000 which have all been donated to the cancer ward at Children's Memorial.

Now Fair Game in Downers Grove wants to help out too. This Saturday, April 30th, Fair Game will donate 20% of sales to the Be The Cure foundation.

"When we opened Fair Game, it was done for community reasons first, and 'business' reasons second," explains store owner and founder Josh Stein. "When a local resident can stand up to something as scary as cancer and fight it head-on, and then have the strength to take it even further – that needs to be celebrated. It can only lead to good things."
